The Haunted Mansion

Celebrates 40 Years of Haunting Guests

This year we're asking Guests “**What will you celebrate?**” Well, we're celebrating, too! Out at **Disneyland**® Park, *The Haunted Mansion*, Disney's classic take on a haunted house, recently celebrated its 40th anniversary! This got us thinking about our own version of *The Haunted Mansion* here at the **Magic Kingdom**® Park—and how much a part of the Disney experience it truly is.

Of course, the attraction didn't start out as the intricate blend of scary and silly that we all know and love. Like its 999 specters, *The Haunted Mansion* changed shape and morphed from one concept to another before reaching its final incarnation. In fact, as part of the original **Disneyland**® Park plans, Walt Disney himself initially conceived the attraction as merely a walk-through with few elaborate special effects. After years of deliberation, Imagineers settled on a ride vehicle to transport Guests through the house—and let's not forget that catchy theme song written by Imagineer X. Atencio!

The popularity of the attraction at **Disneyland**® Park ensured that *The Haunted Mansion* would be at the **Magic Kingdom**® Park on opening day here in 1971. Today, it is still a “must ride” attraction for Guests from around the globe. The recent improvements to *The Haunted Mansion* at the **Magic Kingdom**® Park added new effects and a stronger storyline for Guests to enjoy. And, thanks to doom buggies on a constantly moving belt system, *The Haunted Mansion* is a high capacity ride that accommodates large numbers of Guests on a daily basis.

Disney's Oak Trail Golf Course Maintenance

Disney's Oak Trail Golf Course is scheduled for maintenance from Monday, August 31 through Friday, September 4 and will be unavailable for play. During this time, Guests with the *Water Park Fun & More* Option or *Touch of Magic* Passes have three golf alternatives:

- They can play after 3pm (twilight) on the 18-hole **Disney's Palm, Magnolia or Lake Buena Vista** Golf Courses. This offer includes an electric golf cart.
- They can play the back nine of **Disney's Lake Buena Vista** Golf Course between 7:30am and 8:30am.
- They can take a 45-minute golf lesson.

These upgrades are available from August 31 through September 4. There is no additional charge for taking advantage of the above options.

Club rentals, if needed, are \$30 (a savings of \$25 off the regular rental fee). Tee times and lesson reservations are required and can be made by calling 407-WDW-GOLF.
